Revitalisation = a healthy church

A healthy church is centred on the Gospel.

It is a group of redeemed Christians who are learning

- to love God
- to love people
- in their cultural context

In other words, revitalisation = **reconnecting** your church

“Redeemed Christians”

The centrality of the Gospel

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the Gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter and then to the Twelve
(1 Corinthians 15.1-5)

A three dimensional approach to building a healthy church

1. The spiritual dimension (loving God)
2. The social dimension (loving others)
3. The societal dimension (in its cultural context)

Revival is usually seen as just individual and spiritual
